- Tuition (T2202/RL-8 or TL11) ★
- Social assistance and worker's compensation (T5007/RL-5) ★
- RRSP and RIF income (T4RSP/RL-2, T4RIF/RL-2) ★
- Partnership income (T5013/RL-15)
- Information about your leased home (RL-31)
- Any other tax slips and relevés

Receipts

- Children's fitness and arts expenses
- Adoption expenses
- Student loan interest
- Professional or union dues (if not included on your T4)
- Investment advisor fees and interest expenses
- Moving expenses
- School supply expenses (teachers)
- Tools expenses
- Employment expenses & form T2200
- Examination fees for professional designations
- Legal expenses to collect alimony, pension or retiring allowance
- Home renovation/accessibility expenses (if a senior or eligible for the disability tax credit)

- Information about the sale of your principal residence

- Rental property income and expenses
- Self-employed people and commissioned employees

 - Vehicle logbook
 - In-home office expenses
- Volunteer firefighter's or search and rescue volunteer certificate

- Business investment loss information (if you invested in a company that went bankrupt)
